

Clayton's enjoyment in life comes from his prison ministry. His past is behind him. He drives a old blue pickup and on the truck's rear fender a white bold-faced stickers proclaim the source of Clayton's passion--"Jesus Christ." "It's been a nice road," Clayton says. "God has been good to me."
